

Phonics:

Pre-school: This term they will be focusing on Letters and Sounds Phase 1, Aspects 3&4. This will involves games and activities that help them develop their listening, rhythm and rhyme skills.

Reception: This term, the children will take their set 1 sounds that they have been learning and using it to segment and blend words in reading books. Beginning to become confident in being fluent readers.

Literacy:

Each week we will have a story or book theme that we will base our learning around which we will let you know about in our newsletter update. We will be looking at varied text types of fiction and nonfiction.

We will provide a variety of activities related to the story of the week and will give the children opportunities to story map, act the stories out, use puppets and many other resources to help them engage with the stories and get to know them really well. We will also engage in a variety of reading and writing activities.

Maths:

Pre-school: The children will continue their learning through number blocks. Learning about what number amounts look like along with partitioning numbers into simple number facts (4 + 3 makes 7.)

Reception:

- Counting and comparing numbers to 10.
- Measure
- Number binds to 10
- Subtracting amounts
- Exploring patterns
