Phonics:

Pre-school: This term they will be focusing on Letters and Sounds Phase 1, Aspects 5&6. This will involve games and activities that help develop their listening, rhythm and rhyme skills, along with beginning to recognise letters and their corresponding sound.

Reception: This term, the children will continue to learn their set 2 sounds and apply this to read and write unfamiliar words.

Literacy:

Each week we will have a story or book theme that we will base our learning around which we will let you know about in our newsletter update. We will be looking at varied text types of fiction and non-fiction.

We will provide a variety of activities related to the story of the week and will give the children opportunities to story map, act the stories out, use puppets and many other resources to help them engage with the stories and get to know them really well. We will also engage in a variety of reading and writing activities.

Maths:

Reception children will be focusing on the topics below. Pre school children will work on the same topics, however will use physical manipulatives to achieve this.

- Counting on and back
- Numbers to 20
- Volume
- Symmetry of shapes
- Doubling/ halving



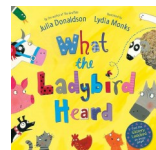
Summer Term: Caring, Sharing and Daring

Topic:

This term our topic is all about superheroes. From Fictional characters to super heroes in our world along with seeing themselves as superheroes. We will be looking at:

This term the children will be learning about relationships, looking into family, friends, falling out, bullying and recognising the difference between these two concepts.

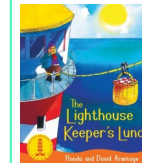
Alongside this, we will be looking at them changing through growing up and respecting their body through food and physical activity.
