

Fred Talk



Phonics:

Pre-school: This term they will be focusing on Letters and Sounds Phase 1, Aspects 1&2. This will involve games and activities that help them develop their listening, rhythm and rhyme skills.

Reception: We will be introducing your children to Read Write Inc (RWI) and will start teaching them their Set 1 sounds with a focus on segmenting and blending to start reading and writing.

Literacy:

Each week we will have a story or book theme that we will base our learning around which we will let you know about in our newsletter update. We will be looking at varied text types of fiction and non-fiction.

We will provide a variety of activities related to the story of the week and will give the children opportunities to story map, act the stories out, use puppets and many other resources to help them engage with the stories and get to know them really well. We will also engage in a variety of reading and writing activities.

Maths:

In our maths the children will build on previous experiences of number from their home and nursery environments, and further develop their subitising (can see a number without counting) and counting skills. They will explore the composition (Understanding a number is made up of smaller numbers) of numbers within 5. They will begin to compare sets of objects and use the language of comparison.

Alongside this, we will be following white rose maths, looking at pattern, measure, shape and numbers to 5.

My community.

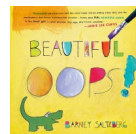
Looking after the environment.

Then will also learn about:

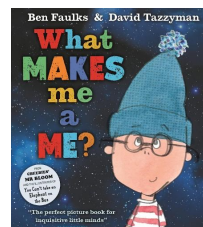
Helping others to feel welcome

Everyone's right to learn

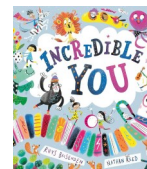
Caring about other people's feelings and working well with others.
