



Reading

Read, Write, Inc:

The children will be split into their reading groups based on their reading level. They will go over their set 2 and 3 sounds, green words and red words. Partner reading features in these sessions.

Fred's Teaching:

This group develops reading fluency and deepens their comprehension skills.

English

We will be looking at the story Hermelin by Mini Grey. The children will explore the pictures, words and sentence structure. They will find and discuss writer's knowledge and experiment with including it within their own writing. The children will plan and write their own detective narrative. Our Year 2 children will edit their work by improving their spellings, vocabulary and grammar.



Maths

We follow the mixed year 1 and 2 White Rose curriculum and this term will be learning about:

- Multiplication and division
- Position and direction
- Fractions
- Time



The children will also continue with their daily mastering number fluency sessions.

Topic

Our key questions will be:

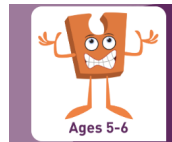
- Who is our current reigning monarch?

- What happened during the Great Fire of London?
- How did the Great Fire of London spread and what changed after?
- How has transport in London changed over time?



PSHE

The children will be covering the unit, 'Relationships'. They will look at the following:

- Families
- Making friends
- Greetings
- People who Help us
- Being my own best friend
- Celebrating my special relationships



Art

We will look at how Philippe Patricio creates transport through collage.

Computing

In this unit, pupils will learn how to insert images and how to create digital writing.

PE

The children will participate in a unit on 'Athletics'. They will learn:

- To develop the sprinting action.
- To develop jumping for distance.
- To develop jumping for height.
- To develop throwing for distance.



Music

In music we will be looking at how music can be improvised.

Science

The children will be learning about plants (bulbs and seeds).

RE
