

## Fred Talk



### Phonics:

Pre-school: This term they will be focusing on Letters and Sounds Phase 1, Aspects 5&6. This will involve games and activities that help them develop their listening, rhythm and rhyme skills.

Reception: This term, the children will continue to learn their set 2 sounds and apply this to read and write unfamiliar words. Continuing to develop their reading and writing skills to write independently.

### Literacy:

Each week we will have a story or book theme that we will base our learning around which we will let you know about in our newsletter update. We will be looking at varied text types of fiction and non-fiction.

We will provide a variety of activities related to the story of the week and will give the children opportunities to story map, act the stories out, use puppets and many other resources to help them engage with the stories and get to know them really well. We will also engage in a variety of reading and writing activities.

### Maths:

Pupils will continue to develop their subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers. The children will also consider strategies for counting larger numbers of objects, including those that cannot be moved. They will build on their knowledge of connecting two equal groups to doubles.

Alongside this, we will be following white rose maths, looking at exploring 3D shapes, manipulate, compose and decompose along with Visualise, build and map.

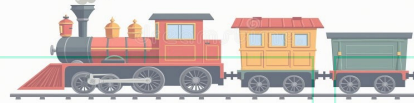


## Spring Term: 'All aboard'

### Topic:

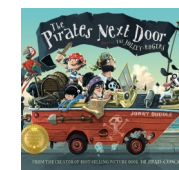
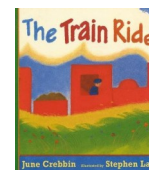
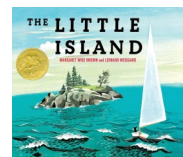
This term our topic is all about investigating lots about transport and travel. What different modes of transport look like and historically what they look like compared to today.
