



## Reading

Read, Write, Inc:

The children will be split into their reading groups based on their reading level. They will go over their set 2 and 3 sounds, green words and red words. Partner reading features in these sessions. The children will take their RWI book home to read with you at home. They will read this three times before changing the book.

The children will read once a week to an adult.

## English

We will be immersing ourselves into our key text, 'Grandad's Island'. We will read the book and watch the video to bring this book to life. The children will look at and discuss images, vocabulary and engage in drama and role play. We will analyse our key text and look at key grammar and language features. This will lead up to the children planning and writing their own return narratives.



## Maths

### Addition and Subtraction



Year One will explore Parts and wholes, writing number sentences, fact families, addition and subtraction.

Year Two will learn about related facts, comparing number sentences and missing number problems.

The children will continue to learn fluency facts through our mastering number programme.
