Fred's Teaching:

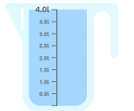
The children who have completed the RWI programme will continue to select a book that matches their accelerated reader reading level.

They will write a diary as part of their second writing outcome.



Maths



Year One will continue to learn about addition and subtraction within twenty and place value within 50.

Year Two will continue with their unit on multiplication and division.

Both year groups will learn about length and height, mass and volume. They will also continue with their daily mastering number sessions to build up their number fluency.

Art We will continue to complete our drawings and paintings on 'The Crying Camel'.

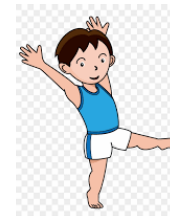


Computing
