- Time

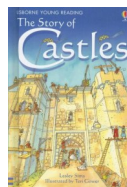
The children will participate in practical maths to embed their thinking across the units.

Art / D&T:

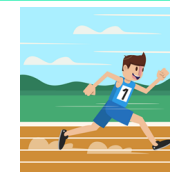
In Art this term our focus will be sculptures. This will be inspired by Andy Goldsworthy and Chris Kenny.
